

Bug find means quarantine works, say winegrowers

AUSTRALIA's wine industry says the discovery of six brown marmorated stink bugs in a consignment of timber from the US demonstrates the quarantine system is working.

Biosecurity officers earlier this month found the exotic pests in a shipping container destined for the production of wine barrels.

Vinehealth Australia said the container was fumigated and the insects killed.
