

## South Australia's Plant Quarantine Standard review by Vinehealth

South Australia's Plant Quarantine Standard (SA PQS) is periodically reviewed and improved. Vinehealth Australia has been undertaking a review of conditions relating to phylloxera in the SA PQS since the start of 2018, and it is close to releasing its proposed list of changes for the wine and grape industries to consider, "to strengthen the state quarantine regulations". The next stage is industry consultation. In early December, all vineyard owners and wineries in South Australia will be advised of the proposed changes and will have until 30 June 2019 to provide feedback to Vinehealth Australia. Formal information sessions will be scheduled post-vintage in April and May 2019.
